

Home Learning Plan Year 3

English:

Grammar:

Classroom Secrets - grammar activities which match grammar objectives being taught in lessons will be provided. Sheets will be differentiated to children's ability levels. Guidance for parents and answer sheets will be included. The Powerpoints can also be accessed via Teams.

CGP Workbooks - a weekly grammar activity from the CGP 10 Minute Test books will be provided in home learning packs (either as a workbook or sheet).

Spelling:

Prim Ed Spelling - Relevant units from Prim Ed will be printed. Most children working on Book C. Some children with additional needs are working on individual sheets. Tests will be undertaken on Teams.

Online activities - Children can also play spelling games using the relevant list on Spelling Shed.

Reading:

Books - Children have access to their individual reading books and home school reading record which are kept in their book bag.

Comprehension activities - Children will be provided with a CGP Reading Comprehension activity in their workbook. Some children with additional needs have a different book.

Online activities - Children will be able to access Teach Your Monster to Read, Lexia and/or Reading Plus. They will be allocated reading activities through Activ Learn Reading Bugs.

Writing:

Writing Inputs - where possible, children will access the writing input/activity via Teams. They will complete writing tasks as planned for that week in their writing workbook and upload a photograph via Teams for feedback.

Writing packs - where this is not possible, children will access a writing pack provided as a printed copy or a digital copy via Teams or DBPrimary.

Maths:

3 Minute Maths - Children will complete a timed maths activity.

Maths input - Children will continue to follow the White Rose plans wherever possible with additional tasks supplementing the White Rose worksheets where necessary.

Teaching will either be through direct teaching or Powerpoints via Teams or children will be directed to the White Rose Videos or Oak Academy videos.

Online activities - sessions will be allocated for children to practice their numerical recall using:

TT Rockstars, Numbots, Activelearn and Maths Shed.

Foundation subjects:

Home learning packs will support the weekly topic.

Appendix Two: An example of a Home Learning Timetable

Year 3 timetable for individual children isolating whilst the class are in school:

9:00- 9.15 Handwriting

Photograph your handwriting onto Teams.

9.15-10.30 English

Log into Teams to access lesson.

10 minutes Grammar activity

10 minutes on EdShed practicing this week's spellings

15 minutes on Lexia, Teach Your Monster to Read or Reading Plus

Children to access an English lesson via Teams and then complete a writing task independently.

Children photograph their work and upload on to Teams for feedback.

10.45-11.00 Assembly

Log into Teams to access.

11.00 - 12.00 Maths

Children to access 3 minute maths sheet uploaded on to Teams.

Practice their maths facts with their class teacher.

Children will then follow the lesson via Teams - children photograph their work onto Teams for feedback.

15 minutes on TTRockstars or Maths Shed.

1.00 - 2.30

Independent Treading - children to read their independent reading book for 15 minutes.

Log back into Teams

Foundation subjects: Follow the lesson on Teams

Children photograph their work onto Teams for feedback

2.30-2.45

Listen to the teacher read the class novel via Teams.
