If KS2 children are reading independently, they must make a note in their reading record. We would encourage children to read for pleasure. This may include reading material of their own choice as well as books from school.

Spelling

We continue to ask parents to support children to learning their spellings. Please could you sign their spelling list once a week to show this has been done. The spelling list can be found in the back of reading diaries.

Maths

Children have a maths facts sheet sent home each half term for your information. These facts will be tested each Friday.

This term we will continue to deliver our weekly Skills Builder assembly with a particular focus on 'Leadership' and 'Teamwork'.
